Motion: The NCLA Executive board has reviewed the NCLA Constitution and Bylaws and have several proposed revisions. According to Article XIV of the constitution, "Amendments to the Constitution may be voted on only when a quorum of the Association is present, and shall require a two-thirds vote of the members present. Notice of the proposed changes in the Constitution shall be mailed to the membership at least 30 days prior to the meeting at which a vote is to be taken on the proposed changes." We will be taking a vote on the proposed changes during the business meeting at the All Conference Luncheon on Friday, October 20th at 12:00pm.

Primarily, they align NCLA's governing documents with current practice, correct inadvertent oversights, and make workflows more efficient.
