How it began

- October 2006
 - Pilot group formed to plan consortium IR.
 - ASU, ECU, UNCG, UNCP, UNCW, UNCC
 - UNCC later decided to go their own direction

■ May 2007

■ Content and Timetable

- items to be included
- 1 year away from an IR

■ Platforms

- Digital Commons, ePrints, Fedora, and ContentDM
- Home grown - UNCG
 - Other products didn't support a shared IR
 - Cost effective \$3500 vs. \$16,000+ per school
 - Centralized hosting
 - Fully customizable

■ October 2007

■ Members met to review:

- Content
- File types
- Basic policy guidelines
- Metadata standards
- Inclusion of ETDs

■ January 2008

■ UNCG demonstrates IR Admin Module

- Members offered suggestions, additions, etc.
